My phrase about our Club is "**And this is how we roll**". So come join us and see how we roll.


The **first meeting** with potential members, hosted by founder, Dena Spain, and cofounder, Sheila Wise, was held on **July 18, 2009**. Those present were given an overview of the vision of the founder and was presented by-laws for review and/or change and acceptance. After meeting with the potential members, several volunteered to aid "It's A Family Affair Child Care" personnel in hosting a strike-a-thon to raise money for the St. Jude's Research Center.

Also, in the beginning, the original club name was "Divas in Control", but after bowling in a tournament in Fredericksburg, Virginia (Alice tournament), there was another group there with a similar name and Dena Spain, founder, immediately changed the name. In **September 2009, the Sassy But Classy Ladies Bowling Club was created.**

The positions for office were announced and nominations made. At the August meeting, nominees were presented and voted for office. In September 2009, the following ladies were installed as the first officers of the Sassy But Classy Ladies Bowling Club for the term 2009 -2011:

The members voted that our club colors would be apple green and lavender. From there, the club proceeded to prepare for our first official bowling tournament with club shirts. First, Morganna Gleaton developed a logo for the shirts. After some tweeking, our **club logo** was born:

Having members who are Breast Cancer survivors, the Club held its own fundraiser for the **Susan B. Komen Breast Cancer fund** by raising \$1000.00 and participating in the Walk-for-the-Cure in June 2011.



We continued to support Breast Cancer Awareness by bowling in the **Bowl-for-the-Cure** fundraising event.



SBCL formed its **first bowling league as a summer trios league in May 2012** at the Marlow Heights Bowling Center on Tuesday evenings. Initially the league was limited to members of the SBCL bowling club, but later extended to other ladies who are not members of the Club. Only members of SBCL are allowed to become officers of the league. The first officers were:

The year 2020 started as any other – nothing eventful. Then in mid-March, we found ourselves in the middle of a pandemic called the Coronavirus (referred to as COVID-19) that not only hit our country, but the world. Thousands of people contracted the virus and many lost their life to the virus. People were stunned! Our normal world was no longer normal!

Nobody really knew what caused the virus (especially being worldwide), there was no immediate cure, and it seemed far in the future before a vaccine would be developed to offset the virus that was running rampant. Everyone was quarantined and panic set in. Businesses shut down, jobs were on hold, church doors closed, bowling centers were forced to close also. Nobody could predict what tomorrow would bring. Family members and friends were becoming sick, but you could not assist for fear you would also become a victim.

As a result of the events taking place, the Board of Directors made a decision to forego all activities of the Club. The Club would no longer hold in-person meetings or require members to pay monthly dues. Since the bowling centers were closed, of course, there were no bowling tournaments or bowling league activities. Our bowling world came to a complete halt!

In September, a ZOOM meeting was held to check on members since we were no longer in contact through our various activities. We were thankful for the technology that allowed us to see other members' faces, and to talk and catch up on each other.

The Board decided to postpone until further notice any Club activities. Development of a vaccine allowed people to be vaccinated and begin to return to “normal”. As a result, the Board determined the Club could be reactivated by the 2021-2022 bowling season.

\*\*Officers were to be elected in 2021; however, the pandemic precluded the Club from holding this event. The Executive Board continued to serve during the pandemic and when SBCL reactivated in August 2022. Election of officers was postponed until 2023. A call for nominations and election will occur in August 2023. Officers will be installed September 2023.

On December 17, 2022, the Club celebrated the holidays, the first major event since reactivating the Club after COVID-19.













At the January Meeting 2023, **Shaquanda Goss** volunteered to become the new Events Coordinator.



Shaquanda Goss resigned effective December 31, 2025.

At the General Meeting on July 12, 2025, **Eugenia Durham-Sims** volunteered to become the Events Coordinator.



Officers were installed by Founder, Dena Spain, September 9, 2023. Members elected to continue with the current officers on July 12, 2025. Officers will serve a new term from September 2025 to September 2027.
